COVID-19 Quarantine

Quarantine Guidance for Students Exposed to COVID-19

Unvaccinated Students



For lower-risk exposures at school where masks were worn correctly:

Option #1: Stay in class. May stay in school if remains symptom-free with a negative test result; must test twice (one test ASAP and one on/after day 5). Continue to wear mask, no extracurricular activities during 7-day quarantine.

For all other exposures (occurred outside of school or without masks):

Option #2: Stay home 7 days. May return on day 8 if no symptoms and they test negative once (on/after day 5).

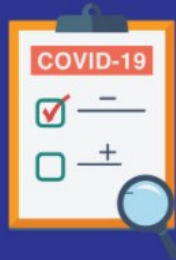
OR

Option #3: Stay home 10 days. Without a test, may return on day 11 after exposure if no symptoms.



Fully Vaccinated Students:

- Quarantine not required if student has no symptoms.
- A COVID-19 test between days 3-5 after exposure is recommend.
- Continue to wear a mask, watch for symptoms, and avoid higher-risk situations (visiting unhealthy family, going to parties) for 14 days after exposure. If symptoms develop, stay home and get tested for COVID-19.



Modified Quarantine

Is **only available** to students who were properly masked, have been tested, and are not showing symptoms.

If Fully Vaccinated

Fully vaccinated students exposed to COVID-19 may refrain from quarantine following a known exposure if asymptomatic.

If Unvaccinated & Masked

When both parties are masked, unvaccinated students who are close contacts may undergo a **modified 10-day quarantine**. They may continue to attend school for in-person instruction if they:

- Are asymptomatic;
- Continue to appropriately mask, as required;
- Undergo twice weekly testing during the 10-day quarantine; and
- Refrain from all extracurricular activities at school, including sports, and community activities.

If Unvaccinated & Unmasked

Unvaccinated close contacts* who were not wearing masks or for whom the infected individual was not wearing a mask must undergo a quarantine off campus. They must self-monitor for symptoms and follow all recommended non-pharmaceutical interventions (e.g., wearing a mask when around others, hand washing, avoiding crowds) through Day 14 from last known exposure. If any symptoms develop during this 14-day period, the exposed person must immediately isolate, get tested and contact their healthcare provider with any questions regarding their care.

*Close Contact — More than 15 minutes over a 24-hour period within 0-6 feet indoors.

Those who remain asymptomatic may:

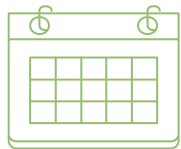
End quarantine after Day 10 from the date of last exposure without testing.

OR

End quarantine after Day 7 from date of last exposure with a negative test collected after Day 5.

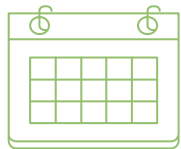
