Regional ICU Capacity



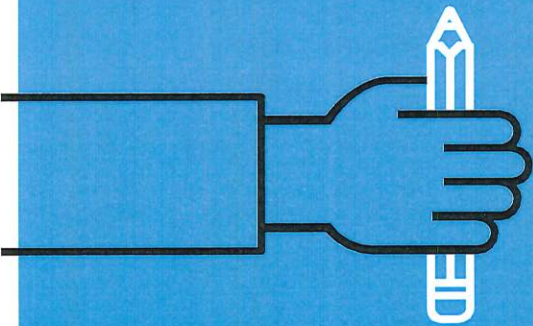
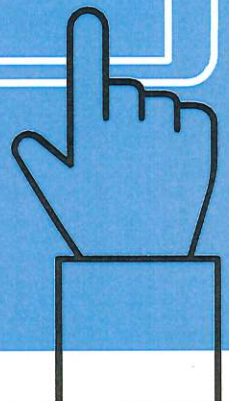
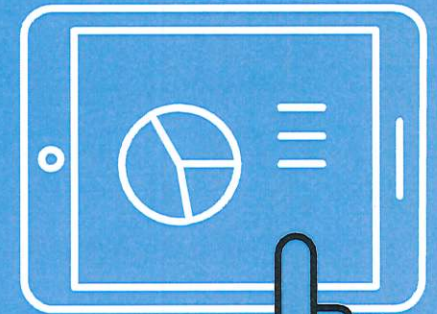
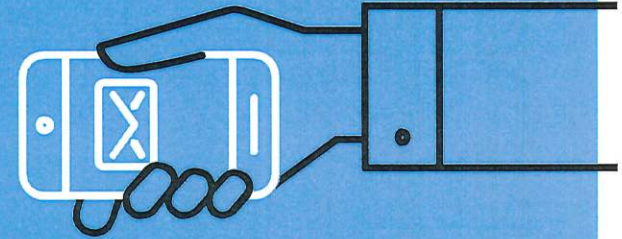
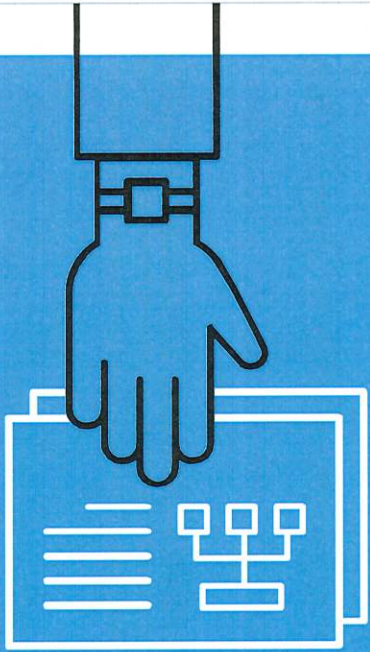

School Bus Procedures

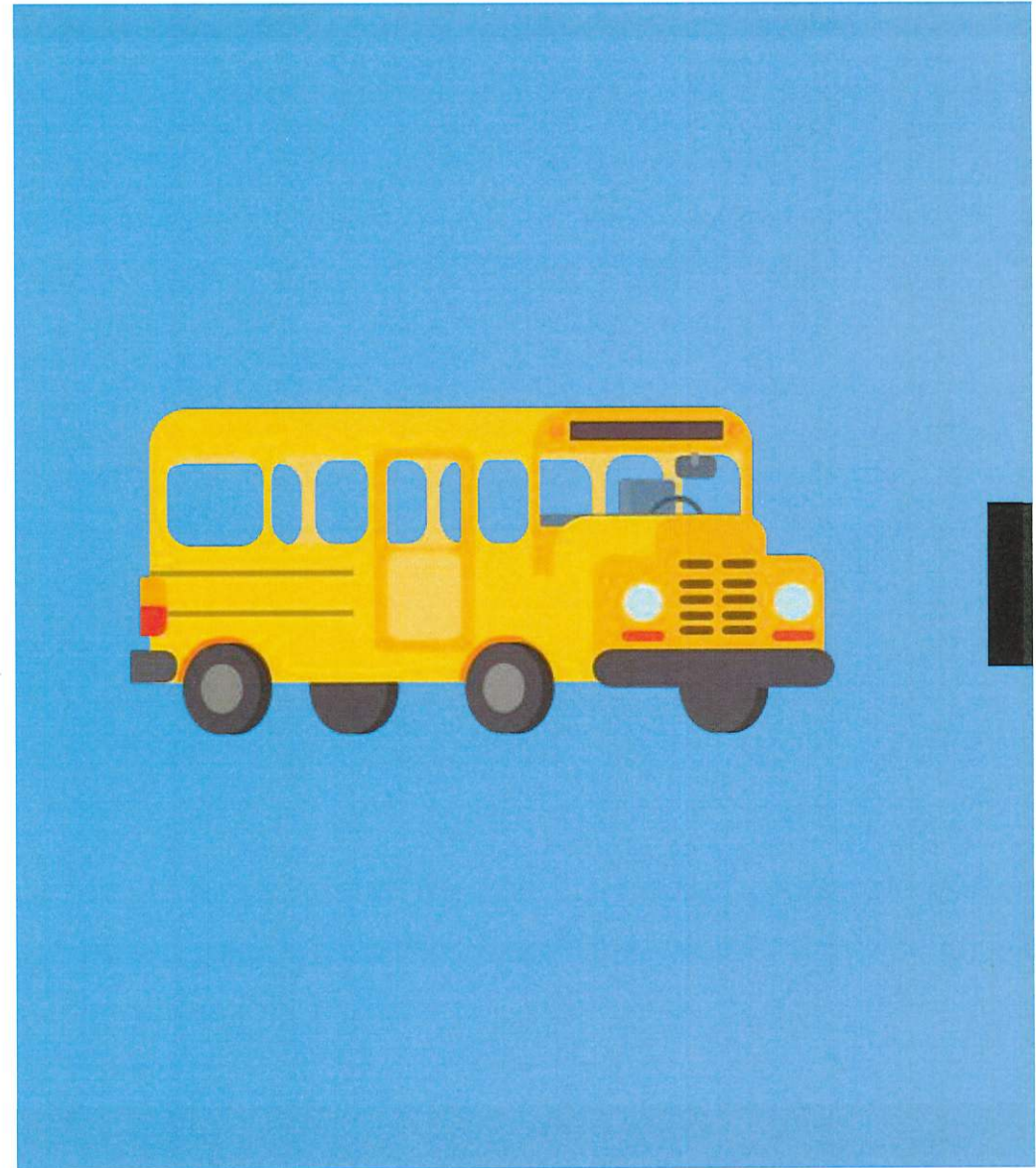
Students will have their temperature checked as they load the bus

One student per seat unless from the same family

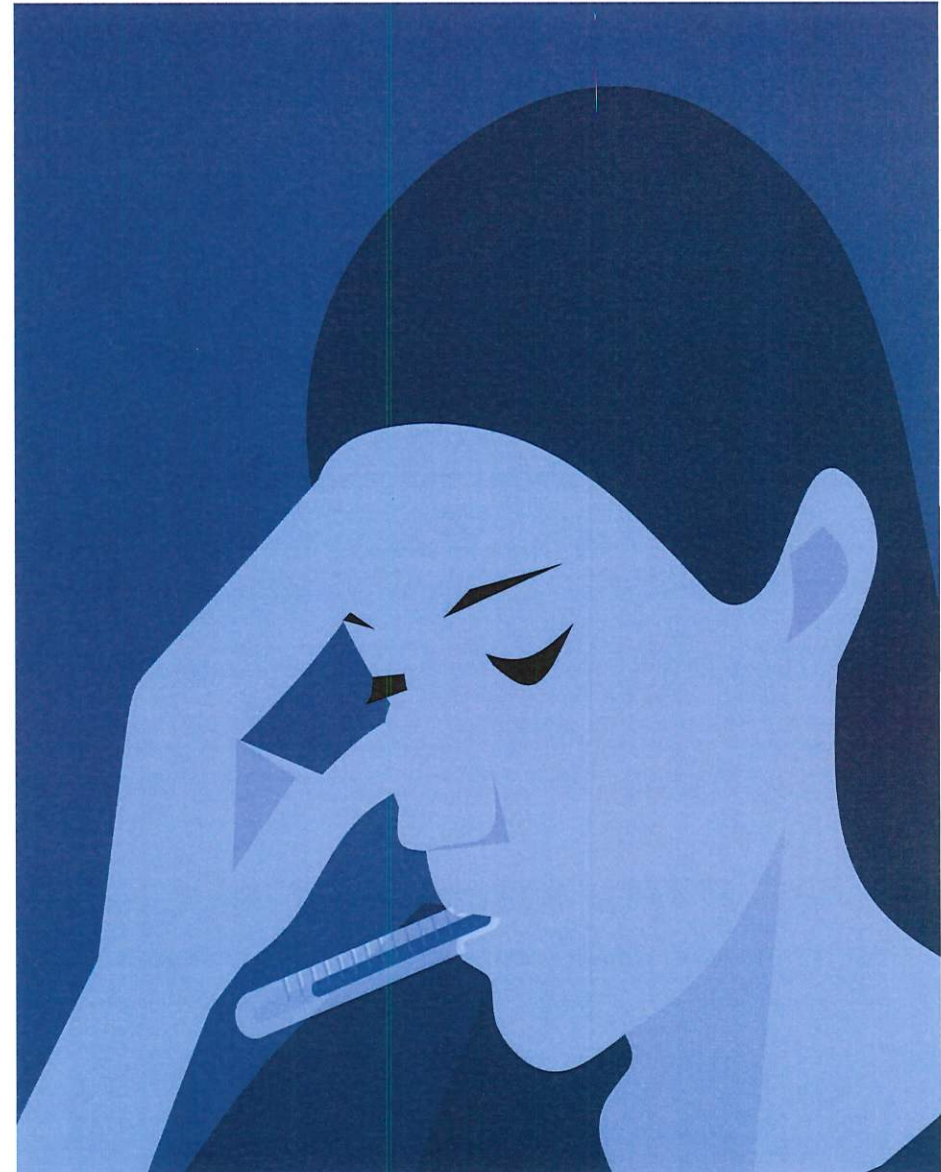
Social distance to the extent practicable

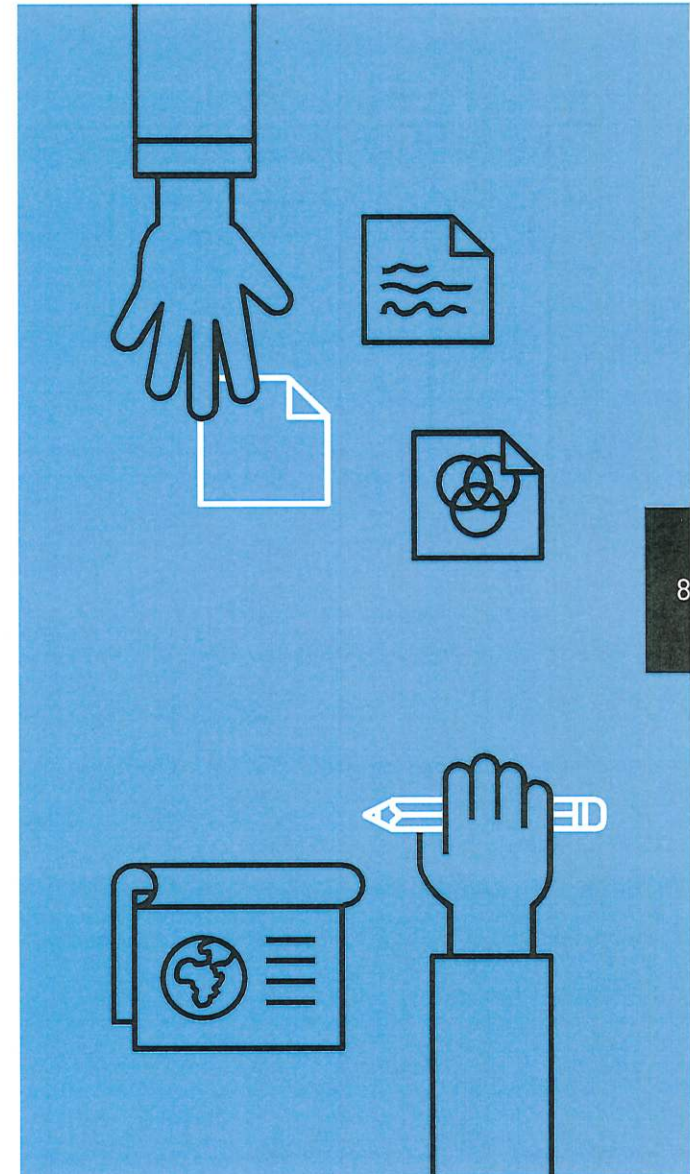


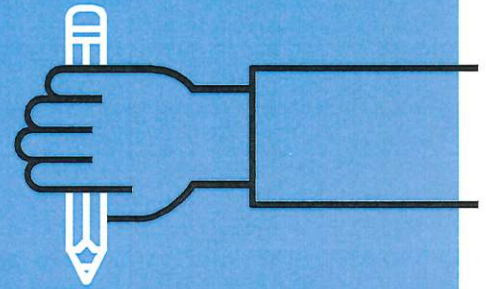
Hybrid Cleaning

The following items have been delivered to each classroom:

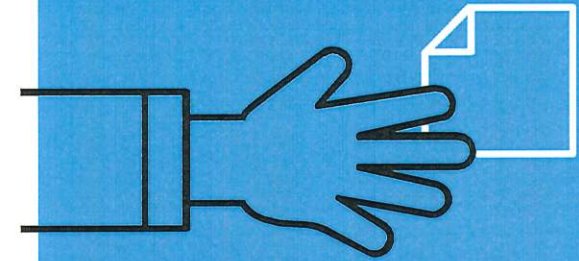
- 3) bottles of hand sanitizer

Instructional aides will support EL students in small groups during homework lab

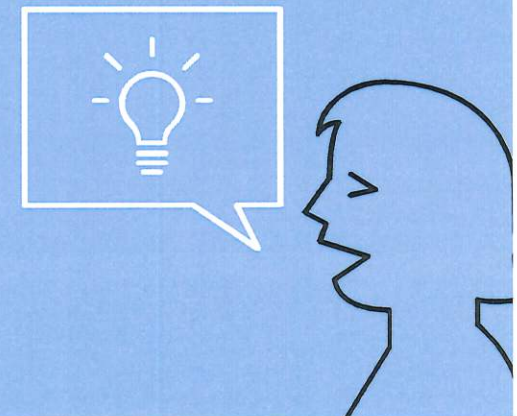




Band and Choir
